

QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

President – Must be 35 years of age, 14-year resident within US. Must be born a US Citizen.

US Senate – Must be 30 years of age, 9-year US Citizen.

US House – Must be 25 years of age, 7-year US Citizen. (May run outside their district Art. 6, Sec. 6)

NC Senate – Must be 25 years of age and 2-year resident of State and 1-year resident of District preceding election.

NC House – Must be 21 years of age and 1-year resident of State preceding election.

Governor – Must be 30 years of age, 5-year US Citizen, 2-year State resident preceding election.

Lt. Governor – Must be 30 years of age, 5-year US Citizen, 2-year State resident preceding election.

All Judges and District Attorney – Must be an attorney and at least 21 years of age.

County Commissioner – Must be 21 years of age by the time they take office and a Rockingham County registered voter.

Municipal Offices – Must be 21 years of age by the time they take office and must live in the municipality for which they are running.

School Board – Must be 21 years of age by the time they take office and must live in the school district for which they are running.

Soil and Water District Supervisor - Must be 21 years of age by the time they take office and a Rockingham County registered voter.

Nothing in the Constitution allows anyone between the ages of 18 and 21 to hold office.
